CONDUCT OF CLINICAL SUPERVISION IN BOSTON DISTRICT

- 1. To provide a continuing improvement in schools, ensuring a smooth delivery of teaching and learning instruction, this Office informs all concerned to conduct a Clinical Supervision on March 14-15, 2024 in Boston District.
- 2. The activity aims to brace up the personal and professional qualities of school heads and teachers towards improving learners' learning outcomes in a responsive educational environment that fosters holistic development of learners as embodied in DepEd's MATATAG Agenda.
- 3. In the event that a teacher manifests an exemplary performance during class observation, he or she shall be recommended for an on-the-spot incentive in a form of performance award.
- 4. The monitoring team is reminded to follow the phases of clinical supervision, which include pre-observation conference, observation, strategy and analysis, supervision conference, and post conference.
- 5. The list of teams and their assigned schools to visit is annexed as *Enclosure 1*, while *Enclosure 2* details the Technical Assistance and Performance Monitoring and Coaching Forms.
- 6. As practiced, the morning session will focus on Clinical Supervision activities, while the afternoon will be spent to hold an exit conference with school heads and members of each team.
- 5. Meals, snacks, travel, and other allowable expenses of the monitoring teams shall be charged to the Division MOOE for division personnel, and District MOOE/SEF/Local Funds for District Supervisors/In-Charge, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 6. Immediate dissemination and compliance of this Memorandum is highly enjoined.
