- 3. Reorient School Heads on the guidelines and context of IPEd Framework as their guide for field implementation;
- 4. Present and craft learning resources related from the content discussed;
- 5. Explain the importance of assessment on learning;
- 6. Apply the pedagogy in teaching through demonstration teaching synthesizing the content, learning resources and assessment;
- 7. Validate the implementation of CLAP in the field through classroom observation; and
- 8. Craft re-entry action plan (REAP) for district/school cascading; and
- 9. Engage participants in workshops on contextualizing and enhancing instructional materials for indigenous learners.

All concerned school heads/participants are directed to bring with you, the hard copy of the edited history of your school with cover page and the additional assignment output during the writeshop at Baywalk Tourist Inn last August 8-9, 2024, laptop, extension wire, WIFI for any internet connection available, least learned competencies during the First Quarter for School Year 2024-2025.

This Office grants Service Credits/Compensatory Overtime Credits to the teachers and education leaders who are involved in the implementation of this activity for the services rendered based on the DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 or the Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to the Teachers subject to the existing CSC and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No.2, s. 2004 or non-monetary remuneration for the overtime services rendered if the activity will be conducted on Saturday, Sunday or holiday.
