- 6. The Public Schools District Supervisors and District Mathematics Coordinators shall lead the conduct of the School and District Mathematics Fair. Each lead is empowered to come up with implementation mechanism to ensure no disruption of classes for the participating schools across all levels of Mathematics Fair.
- 7. The Public Schools District Supervisors must ascertain that the classes left by the teacher-participants are taken over by substitute teachers, merged with other classes, or given an alternative instruction or delivery mode so that the learners still avail of the full benefit of classroom instruction.
- 8. All participants to be billeted in the assigned schools are advised to bring their own sleeping gears, beddings, and toiletries and must ensure the cleanliness and orderliness of the area, thereafter. Since there is no registration fee, they are advised to take care of their own food provisions and may seek the assistance of the host school through the assigned contact persons.
- 9. To conduct this activity in a smooth and organized manner, the Technical Working Group are expected to attend the meeting on October 25, 2024 (1:00 PM) at Madayaw Hall, DepEd Davao Oriental Schools Division Office.
- 10. Travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the participants shall be charged against their respective local fund/MOOE and or other sources subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
