Active engagement in these areas is recognized as crucial to the comprehensive development of learners. To support this, the BLSS-SSD is focused on establishing School Sports Clubs to promote physical fitness, health, and engagement among learners. It is also an avenue for learners to discover and develop their sports potentials. In relation, this Office has developed the DepEd Sports Manual covering thirty (30) sports including paragames.


The DepEd Sports Manual provides essential guides and instructions for the School Sports Club Program, aiming to improve learners' skills across different sports disciplines. To implement this, Sports Skills Training sessions will be conducted from October 2024 onwards at Teacher's Camp, Baguio City, and the training shall be divided into five (5) clusters. This initiative is designed to equip participants with the necessary skills and knowledge for effective sports management and to highlight the role of sports in learner development. In addition, this training will impart best practices, techniques, and values across various sports, thereby empowering participants with confidence and competence needed to lead and support capacity building efforts among other sports stakeholders. These sessions will underscore the importance of sports in addressing the developmental needs of learners, facilitating their engagement in physical activities to promote health and growth.






