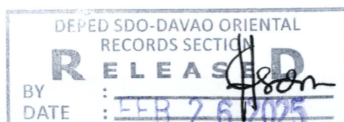
Subject : **COMMEMORATION OF THE 2025 SAFER INTERNET DAY**

COMMEMORATION OF THE 2025 SAFER INTERNET DAY

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Attached is a letter from the National Coordination Center Against OSAEC CSAEM of the Department of Justice dated February 6, 2025, contents of which are self-explanatory.
2. Anent to this, to ensure the implementation of Anti-Online Sexual Abuse and Exploitation of Children (OSAEC) and Anti-Child Sexual Abuse or Exploitation Materials (CSAEM) policies in schools, all Division Offices shall implement the following:
 - a. An instructional classroom-based session on Anti-OSAEC and CSAEM shall be conducted by classroom advisers of Grades 5-6 and Junior High School during their homeroom subjects which shall be delivered on any day of February in observance of the 2025 Safer Internet Day;
 - b. To ensure the effectiveness and efficiency on the conduct of the sessions, the school shall submit to the Schools Division Office, **at the end of the month of February 2025**, the report on the number of learners reached per grade level or those who have attended the classroom-based sessions, including summary of learner rights and protection concerns disclosed during the conduct of the activity; and
 - c. The Division Office shall validate and submit the consolidated report to the Regional Office on the **first week of March 2025**.


