Participation of Learners in UNICEF's U-Report Poll on the National

Framework on Children and Youth Participation

Date : August 15, 2025

1. This is in reference to **DepEd Memorandum DM-OUOPS-2025-**\_\_\_ dated **July 28, 2025**, from the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations, requesting learner-respondents for UNICEF Philippines' *U-Report Poll* in support of the development of the **National Framework on Children and Youth Participation**, in collaboration with the **National Committee on Child and Youth Participation (NCCYP)**, the **National Youth Commission (NYC)**, and the **Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC)**.

2. The U-Report Poll seeks to gather insights from learners aged 13-30 years old to help shape policies, programs, and activities that strengthen youth participation and engagement. This aligns with the provisions of Republic Act No. 10661 (National Children's Month Act) and RA 10742 (Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015), as well as the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC).

- 3. The poll consists of six (6) multiple-choice questions available in English and Filipino. To participate, learners must log in to their Facebook Messenger account, search for U-Report Philippines, and send the word "VOICE" to begin. Detailed instructions and publication materials are attached for reference.
- 4. In compliance with **DepEd Order No. 34, s. 2022** (School Calendar and Activities) and **DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2016** (Policy and Guidelines on the Protection of Children in School), participation shall be **voluntary**. Learners must secure a **signed consent form** from their parents or guardians prior to answering the poll. All collected information will be kept confidential and processed in accordance with **RA 10173** (Data Privacy Act of 2012).
- 5. School Heads/SSLG/SELG Advisers are directed to:
  - a. Disseminate this memorandum to all concerned teachers and learners;
  - b. Facilitate the distribution and collection of Learner Consent Forms; and
  - c. Submit a brief participation report to the **Division Youth Formation Coordinator** on or before **September 1, 2025**.

This is in relation to the ongoing initiative of the National Committee on Child and Youth Participation (NCCYP), specifically of the sub-working group composed of UNICEF Philippines, Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD); National Youth Commission (NYC); and Council for the Welfare of Children (CWC), to develop a National Framework on Children and Youth Participation.

Recognizing the lack of comprehensive data on the state of child and youth participation in the country, UNICEF Philippines launches **U-Report Poll**, a survey that aims to gather insights to shape the development of the Framework and subsequent policies, programs, and activities for children and youth.

To access the Poll, respondents shall log into their Facebook Messenger accounts, search for U-Report Philippines, and send "VOICE" to begin answering the survey.



To achieve the target number of respondents, Regional Youth Formation Coordinators (RYFCs) and Division Youth Formation Coordinators (DYFC) shall ensure that all Schools Divisions will be represented and accumulate a total of 450 responses from each region on or before September 5, 2025. Regions can exceed the target should they wish to.

Each learner-respondent and their parent/guardian must accomplish the Learner and Parental Consent Form. The consolidated forms are requested to be uploaded by the RYFCs to their designated folder via https://tinyurl.com/ConsentUReportPoll Kindly follow the file name format: Region\_Surname, Given Name\_Parent/Learner Consent (e.g., Region 1\_Dela Cruz, Juan\_Parent Consent). 




