Relative to the invitation of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST) – Provincial Science and Technology Office in collaboration with the City Government of Mati and other partner agencies, this Office encourages all interested students and teachers to the first local Regional Science, Technology, and Innovation Week (RSTW) celebration with the theme, Siyensya, Teknolohiya at Inobasyon: Kabalikat sa Matatag, Maginhawa, at Panatag na Kinabukasan – Building Smart and Sustainable Communities on September 10–12, 2025, at the Sambuokan Hall, City Hall of Mati, Davao Oriental.

The three-day event aims to enhance public awareness, understanding, and appreciation of Science, Technology, and Innovation (STI) and its impact on daily life.

Highlights of the event include:

- Interactive Exhibits that will feature the Finger Tingler, Steady Hand, Rope Puzzle, Bernoulli Blower, Van de Graaff Generator;
- Technology Showcases such as the Vertical Helophyte Filter System, Automated Weather Station, 3D Printing, and Artificial Coral Reefs;
- Mobile Planetarium for an immersive experience in astronomy and space science;

- Side Forum on technologies for agriculture, aquaculture, wastewater management, coral reef regeneration, and renewable energy; and
- Locally-developed technologies, project cooperators, and S&T products and services.

This activity is open to the public and free of charge. Thus, all schools are highly encouraged to organize student (with chaperon) and teacher visits to the


