PARTICIPATION TO JOURNEWS DIVISION CAMPUS JOURNALISM

TRAINING FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS: YEAR 2

- 1. This Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division, will conduct the JOURNEWS Division Campus Journalism Training for School Paper Advisers: Year 2 on September 26-28, 2025, at Lupon Vocational High School, Lupon, Davao Oriental.
- 2. The aim of the activity is to capacitate the journalistic skills of school paper advisers and promote and sustain responsible campus journalism.
- 3. A registration fee of EIGHT HUNDRED PESOS (P800.00) shall be charged per participant to cover resource speakers' honoraria, meals, accommodation, and travel expenses. The registration fee, along with the meals, travel and incidental expenses, of the participants may be charged to the school's MOOE, Special Education Fund (SEF), or local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
- 4. The expected minimum number of participants is **30 participants (School Paper Advisers and Coaches) per district** and the deadline for sending the names of participants per district is on or before September 23, 2025.
- 5. The participants should bring laptops, cameras (for Photojournalism), extension wires, and Wi-Fi internet modems for the workshops. They are also requested to bring light bedding and other essential items for the training.







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- 6. The training will feature simultaneous individual categories for participants, including News Writing, Feature Writing, Editorial Writing, Sports Writing, Science and Technology Writing, Photojournalism, Copyreading and Headline Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Column Writing, and Mobile Journalism (for Secondary participants only). Meanwhile, the group events will consist of Radio Broadcasting and Scriptwriting, TV Broadcasting (for Secondary participants only), Collaborative Publishing, and Online Publishing (for Secondary participants only).
- 7. Participants and all DOSPAA Officers are expected to arrive on September 26 (Day 0), as a short opening program will begin at 4:00 PM that same day. Accommodation will be provided at designated schools in Lupon West District, with accommodation details given upon the participants' arrival.
- 8. Grant of Service Credits/COC subject to the existing CSC and CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 and DO 53, s. 2003 will be given to the participants for the services rendered on September 27-28, 2025.
- 9. Attached is the matrix of activities and list resource speakers. Please be guided accordingly.
