Subject : **REQUEST FOR SUPPORT – RFSSLG RXI DONATION DRIVE  
“PISO MULA SA PUSO: PISO PARA SA PAGBANGON”**

Date : June 11, 2026

1. This Office informs all concerned that the request of the **Regional Federated Supreme Secondary Learner Government (RFSSLG) of Region XI to conduct the donation drive entitled “Piso Mula sa Pusong Pagbangon” has been approved for implementation** in the Schools Division of Davao Oriental.
2. The initiative aims to mobilize voluntary support from learners, school personnel, and stakeholders for the benefit of learners, families, and communities affected by the recent earthquake, particularly in **Jose Abad Santos, Davao Occidental, as identified by the RFSSLG Region XI.**
3. **The approval granted by this Office is strictly limited to the conduct of this specific donation drive only. It shall not be construed as authority to conduct any other solicitation, fundraising activity, or collection outside the purpose stated in the approved request.**
4. All public secondary schools, through their respective Supreme Secondary Learner Government officers and teacher-advisers, are authorized to participate in the initiative, subject to the following conditions:
  - a. **Participation shall be purely voluntary.** No learner, parent, teacher, school personnel, or stakeholder shall be compelled, pressured, or required to contribute.

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- b. No fixed amount shall be imposed. Contributions shall be accepted only according to the willingness and capacity of donors.
  - c. Collection, safekeeping, remittance, reporting, and documentation of all donations shall be handled with the highest standards of transparency, accountability, and propriety.
  - d. All collections shall be properly recorded using a school-level donation log, indicating the date, source or donor category, amount collected, person responsible, and remittance details.
  - e. No portion of the collected donations shall be used for administrative, operational, transportation, communication, or incidental expenses.
  - f. Donations shall be remitted only to the official account or mode of transfer designated by the RFSSLG Region XI and communicated through the Division Youth Formation Coordinator.
  - g. Schools shall not use unauthorized personal accounts, informal collection channels, or undocumented remittance arrangements.
6. **All participating schools are directed to complete the collection and remittance of donations on or before June 26, 2026. After remittance, schools shall submit the required report through the official online reporting link provided by the RFSSLG Region XI and shall furnish the Division Youth Formation Coordinator with a copy of the proof of remittance and summary report for monitoring and consolidation purposes.**
7. School Heads shall provide direct supervision over the conduct of the initiative in their respective schools. SSLG Teacher-Advisers shall guide the learner-leaders in the proper implementation of the activity and shall ensure that all processes are documented, transparent, and consistent with DepEd policies and child protection principles.
8. This activity shall not disrupt classes and shall not interfere with the delivery of basic education services. Any school-level coordination shall be undertaken during appropriate non-instructional time or in a manner that does not affect teaching-learning activities.
9. No funds from the Division Office shall be allocated for this activity. Any incidental school-level requirement related to coordination or documentation shall be subject to existing budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and



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regulations and shall not be charged against or deducted from the collected donations.

10. The Division Youth Formation Coordinator shall monitor the implementation of this initiative, consolidate submitted reports, and coordinate with the RFSSLG Region XI for the proper acknowledgment and documentation of the Division's participation.

11. For inquiries and further coordination, all concerned may communicate with Mr. Michael A. Mangkikis, PDO I and Division Youth Formation Coordinator, through the School Governance and Operations Division.

12. Immediate and strict compliance with this Memorandum is directed.


